The teaching collection at the Center contains a diversity of plants that range from ancient tree ferns and cycads to a large number of economically important plants from around the world.

1 p.m. Enjoy a performance while you dine at the [Lampost Theatre Company](#). Choose a program that fits the interests of your group.

3:30 p.m. Stretch your legs while you tour [Viking Pump](#). See first hand how pumps are made to being shipped to distributors.

5:00 p.m. Experience New Orleans dining at [Bourbon Street](#) which offers Cajun, Creole and American fare.

7 p.m. Finish your day by sitting back and enjoying a performance at either the [Gallagher-Bluedorn Performing Arts Center](#) located on the University of Northern Iowa campus or at the [Oster Regent Theater](#) located in downtown Cedar Falls and listed in the National Register of Historic Places.
