Cedar Valley Tourism Partner,

We are preparing to celebrate Tourism Month in May, and we're contacting YOU to seek input for the 2015 Cedar Valley Tourism Awards! Honorees will be selected through a three-step process – step one is collection of nominations – step two is voting – and step three is celebrating!

First we are seeking nominations from the public. Self-nominations are encouraged. **Simply send a short description – 25-50 words** (not a coupon, deal, or “pitch”) to [Marshall.Boyer@cedarfallstourism.org](mailto:Marshall.Boyer@cedarfallstourism.org). If you prefer US mail, send your nominations to Marshall Boyer, Cedar Falls Tourism and Visitors Bureau, 6510 Hudson Road, Cedar Falls, IA 50613. **Nominations are due March 28.** They will be evaluated by a committee and used to create a ballot.

The second part of the process is the voting. The public will be invited to vote online using a ballot produced with the nominations we receive. **If your event, attraction or business is not nominated, it will not appear on the ballot.** Voting will take place April 1 to April 30.

**Honorees will be announced at our celebration at the Island Park Beach House at 4pm on Wednesday, May 4. You are invited to attend and help us celebrate!**

Here are the award categories:

Attraction of the Year      A local attraction that substantially contributed to the local tourism industry by bringing in a significant number of visitors and enhanced the quality of life in our community.

Event of the Year      A hallmark event or festival that took place during calendar year 2015 and created significant economic impact, attracted substantial out-of-town visitors, generated positive media attention, and/or positively promoted the Cedar Valley as a visitor destination.

Restaurant of the Year      A restaurant that exhibits excellence in service, a positive attitude and attentive staff, quality menu items, ambiance, and ability to provide visitors with a memorable dining experience.

Lodging Establishment of the Year      A lodging establishment that exhibits excellence in service, a positive attitude and attentive staff, an availability of outstanding facilities, ambiance, innovation, and the ability to provide visitors with a memorable stay.

Business/Organization of the Year      An organization that offers a unique product or service that contributes to the local tourism industry. The organization excels in product and service innovation, quality of product experience, and supports higher quality of life and tourism-related goals.

Events, attractions and businesses that have been honored in the past three years are ineligible. We congratulate the following for recent recognition and encourage you to consider them for future nominations – just not this year.
