

# cedar falls tourism FY24 Annual Report



Cedar Falls saw a second year in a row of record-breaking hotel tax collection. In our city, 50 percent of these funds go to Cedar Falls Tourism as we continue to market the area to visitors. The other 50 percent is used to enhance our quality of life through culutral programs, parks, and trails.



## **FY24 ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

#### **Meetings & Conferences**

- Hosted 38 meetings/conferences (21 new)
  - Estimated Attendees: 5,280
  - Estimated Overnights: 3,540
  - Estimated Economic Impact: \$1,052,253
- Hosted 8 conventions/trade shows (1 new)
  - Estimated Attendees: 38,350
  - Estimated Overnights: 590
  - Estimated Economic Impact: \$2,811,933
- Hosted 10 site visits with meeting planners with 8 of those booking in Cedar Falls following visit
- Created a VIP experience program with conference hotels

#### **Sports**

- Cedar Falls hosted 21 sporting events (4 new)
  - Estimated Attendees: 93,600
  - Estimated Overnights: 6,943
  - Estimated Economic Impact: \$10,796,418
- Executed new welcome signage for IHSAA State Football



- Ran digital advertising campaigns and placed advertising throughout the year promoting trails, weekend getaways, holiday events, and family-friendly trips
- Secured \$10,000 Iowa Tourism Grant specifically for digital bike trail promotion in Wisconsin and Minnesota
- Hired a content coordinator position to the staff to elevate messaging
- Hosted travel journalists and influencers
- Promoted Cedar Falls at the Iowa Bike Expo in Des Moines, Canoecopia in Madison, WI, and Omaha Boat & Travel Show
- Cedar Falls Visitor Center was named an Iowa Welcome Center Partner

- Coordinated Panthers on Parade with 27 6 foot tall TC mascots across Cedar Falls/Cedar Valley to showcase the community's UNI pride
  - Shared Cedar Falls Tourism and industry updates via new quarterly email
