- Begin your visit at the **University of Northern Iowa's Tallgrass Prairie Center**. Tour the center and prairie and learn about Iowa Prairies or Prairie Urban Gardening. Participants may experience cleaning and sorting seeds. www.tallgrassprairiecenter.org (2 hours)
- Experience the award winning atmosphere at **Barn Happy**. This 1925 dairy barn has been converted into an Iowa experience. Enjoy homemade soup and dessert for lunch. Then browse the Iowa products in the barn and reminisce amongst the antiques in the loft. It's a barn good time! www.barnhappy.net (90 Minutes)
- Continue your outdoor education at **Hartman Reserve** with a program on Bird Watching, Butterflies, Pioneers Life or Wildflowers. Enjoy a tram ride through this 340-acre nature preserve nestled near a quiet neighborhood in Cedar Falls/Waterloo. www.hartmanreserve.org (2 hours)
- Before heading home, visit the **Cedar Valley Arboretum** where your group will relish a self-guided tour through the gardens and a tractor pulled wagon ride highlighting the Butterfly Meadow. Enjoy a Scratch Cupcake and beverage before heading home. www.cedarvalleyarboretum.org (90 Minutes)

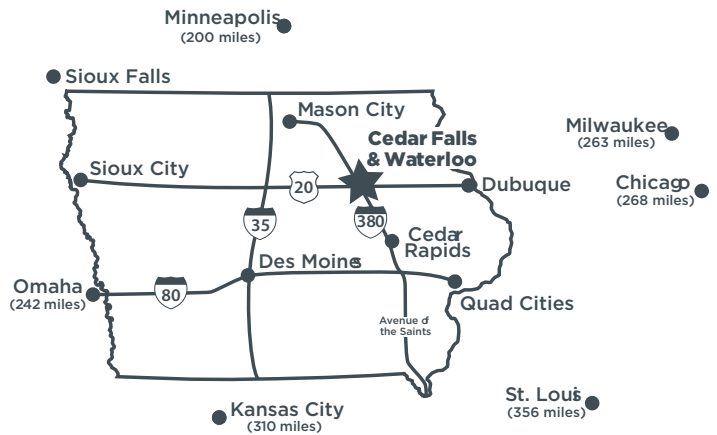
Combine a shopping excursion amidst the unique specialty shops of Downtown Cedar Falls with a little pampering at a full-service spa.
