DAY 1

Arrive at the hotel of your choice. Cedar Falls offers two full-service hotels and seven additional hotels offer free continental breakfast and group amenities.

Meander in the Downtown District; there's something for everyone—from locally owned specialty shops, coffee and tea, public art exhibits, historic buildings and Riverwalk.

Dine like a local! George's Local, Los Cabos, Maid-Rite, Montage, Pump Haus Grill, Tony's LaPizzeria and Whiskey Road are just a few of the many choices your group can choose from when dining on their own in downtown Cedar Falls.

DAY 2

After a leisurely breakfast at your hotel, it is time to enjoy a day at the College Hill Arts Festival, the Sturgis Falls Celebration and Cedar Basin Music Festival, ARTapalooza or one of the 13+ annual events that are offered in the Cedar Falls and Waterloo communities. (3+ hours)

Enjoy a private catered dinner in a historic Victorian Home hosted by the Cedar Falls Woman's Club. After dinner experience Laughing Yoga. This fun session is not strenuous and the only requirement is laughing. Cedarfallswomansclub.com (2 hours)



DAY 3

After breakfast at your hotel head out to tour the Ice House Museum located on the banks of the Cedar River. The circular building, built in 1921 once stored ice cut from the Cedar River. It now features interactive displays that tell the ice harvesting story.

Stroll through the Hearst Center for the Arts' Sculpture Garden then head inside to view artwork by local and regional artists. Finish your visit by creating your own art project facilitated by a Hearst staff member. thehearst.org (1.5 hours)

Enjoy homemade soup, salad and dessert at Barn Happy. This renovated dairy barn offers a gift shop featuring Iowa goods. barnhappy.net (90 min.)

A knowledgeable guide will join your group at Barn Happy and will enlighten you on the history of Cedar Falls and Waterloo as you travel Historic Route 20 from Barn Happy to Petersen & Tietz Greenhouse. Highlights along the way include downtown Cedar Falls and the Black Hawk County Freedom Rock.

Visit the Sullivan Brothers Iowa Veterans Museum which honors the service and sacrifice of all Iowa Veterans from Civil War to present. Step into their stories through traditional exhibits, interactive activities and an electronic Wall of Honor. An exhibit of the Sullivan living room honors the five Sullivan brothers of Waterloo, Iowa who were serving together on the USS Juneau and lost their lives are part of Waterloo's and the nation's history. After your tour, enjoy a catered dinner in the beautiful glass lobby under the p51D Mustang. Groutmuseumdistrict.org (2.5 hours)

DAY 4

Before you journey home, visit the Cedar Falls Visitor Center; pick up brochures to share with friends and family, purchase last minute souvenirs, enjoy a pastry or roll from a local bakery and a stroll around the lake.
