## Cedar Falls Businesses and Volunteer Honored by Iowa Tourism Industry

CEDAR FALLS, IOWA (OCTOBER 30, 2017) — Two Cedar Falls businesses, Barn Happy and the BlackHawk Hotel were honored with awards at the 2017 Iowa Tourism Conference.
